AIG in Action: Belize

May 2012 – During a volunteer trip organized by the University of Alabama, six students were injured when their bus hit a wall and overturned. AIG's Travel Guard was immediately contacted, where assistance coordinators:

- Dispatched a specialist to Belize to manage communications and services between medical providers, students, university program coordinators, and the students' families
- Coordinated ground ambulance transfer to the nearest diagnostic center and covered testing procedures including CT scans, MRI scans, and X-rays
- Organized ground transportation between the clinic, hotel, and airport, as well as meals
- Arranged hotel stays near the airport for the injured students
- Ensured frequent contact and the safe return of all six students to their respective hometowns

9. On his way to Italy, Peter's luggage is lost, with his insulin left inside the bag. He needs help to locate it as soon as possible and have an emergency prescription filled. Who does he call?
10. It is Sam's first extended trip to Europe for a semester, and his passport and wallet are stolen on his first week there. Where does he turn to for emergency cash, and how will he get his passport replaced?
