#### Am I Eligible?

#### **Domestic Students**

#### **International and IEI Students**

All F-1 and J-1 International students and Intensive English for International(IEI) students are required to have health insurance coverage. Eligible students will be automatically enrolled in the Student Health Insurance Plan at registration, and the Premium will be added to the student's bursar account unless proof of comparable coverage is provided by completing the waiver.\*
