General Information

Am I Eligible

All registered hybrid students taking 3-6 credit hours per 5-week term are required to have health insurance coverage, either through the Unity Environmental University Student Health Insurance Plan (SHIP) or through another individual or family plan. Eligible students will be automatically enrolled in the (SHIP) and the premium will be added to the student's tuition fees unless proof of comparable coverage is provided by completing a waiver. Distance Education students are not eligible to enroll.

Dependents

Dependents are not eligible.

How Do I Waive/Enroll?

To Waive/Enroll:

Eligible students who know they want the Unity Environmental University SHIP can confirm coverage and receive their ID card sooner by logging into their Unity Environmental University Student Portal in terms that occur prior to December 15, 2024 for the Annual Policy. New students attending terms beginning after January 1, 2025, must confirm by the start of their first term. Eligible students wishing to waive the Unity Environmental University SHIP may do so by logging into their Unity Environmental University Student Portal in terms that occur prior to December 15, 2024, for the Annual policy. New students attending terms beginning after January 1, 2025, must waive by the start of their first term.

The deadline to waive coverage for Annual coverage is 08/15/2024.
